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Food Protection Management Courses

The Food Protection Management Training Program seeks to reduce the risk of food borne illness.

Two classes pertaining to food safety will be offered by the Wise County Extension office during the month of August.

- Food service <u>managers</u> can attend a two day certification training on Wednesday, August 2, 2017 from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm and Friday, August 4 from 8:30 to approximately 1pm (includes exam which follows conclusion of course) at the Wise County Extension office in Decatur. The registration fee of \$125 includes course book and ServeSafe exam. Registration deadline is July 19, 2017 and is limited to the first 15 paid participants.
- Food service employees and those who operate a cottage food business can attend a two hour Food Handler's Class, accredited by the Texas Department of State Health Services, on Wednesday, **August 16** from **2:00pm to 4:30pm** at the Wise County Extension office in Decatur to learn more about good personal hygiene, cross contamination and time and temperature abuse. The registration fee is \$20.00 and covers course materials and an official food handler card. Space is limited.
