## 2023 Wise County Hay Show

Hay Show Rules

1. Official entry forms and hay samples will be received at the Wise County Texas A\&M AgriLife Extension Service ( 206 S. State Street in Decatur) up to Friday, August $18^{\text {th }}$. Please pay the $\$ 10$ entry fee and give us your name, address, phone number and the kind of hay you are submitting (sample number if more than one is submitted). If you need a core sampler to pull your samples, we have one available at the Extension office you can check out. Please return promptly!
2. After the $\$ 10$ entry fee is paid the cost per sample will be $\$ 22$.
3. You may enter no more than 4 entries total per producer. Choose your categories to enter 1-4 samples.
4. Categories:
1) Warm Season Perennial Grasses
2) Warm Season Annual Grasses
3) Cool Season Annual Grasses
4) Mixed Grasses of any kind
5. Hay will be judged and ranked in each category. Hay will be judged by chemical score as follows: $\%$ crude protein $+(100-\%$ ADF $) \quad$ EXAMPLE: $20 \%$ crude protein hay with $25 \%$ ADF $=20+(100-25)=95$
6. Hay entered in the Wise County Hay Show must have been produced in Wise County.
7. Hay Show results will be announced at the Ranchers Gathering on September $25^{\text {th }}$, and prizes will be awarded to the overall winner and three remaining category winners.
